

Research Update:

CTBC Asset Management Co. Ltd. Ratings Affirmed At 'twA+/twA-1'; Outlook Stable

June 28, 2023

Rating Action

Taiwan Ratings Corp. today affirmed its 'twA+' long term ratings and 'twA-1' short term issuer credit ratings on **CTBC Asset Management Co. Ltd.** (CTBC AMC). The outlook on the long-term rating is stable. The ratings reflect our view of a degree of support from the company's financially stronger parent, **CTBC Financial Holding Co. Ltd.** group considering the asset management company's strategically important group status. The ratings reflect CTBC AMC's strong capitalization and adequate funding and liquidity. Counterbalancing factors include the company's limited operating scale and higher risk concentration on real estate management and investment in Taiwan.
