Rating Action

Taiwan Ratings Corp. today affirmed its 'twAA' long-term insurer financial strength and issuer credit ratings on Taiwan Fire & Marine Insurance Co. Ltd. The outlook on the ratings is stable. The ratings reflect the insurer's very strong capital and earnings relative to risk profile, as well as our expectation that the insurer will maintain a prudent business growth strategy with satisfactory underwriting performance. Counterbalancing these strengths are the company's greater vulnerability due to its smaller scale, and less geographic business diversification compared to regional peers.
