CTCI Corp. Ratings Affirmed At 'twA/twA-1'; **Outlook Stable**

March 26, 2025

Rating Action Overview

Taiwan Ratings Corp. today affirmed its 'twA' long-term and 'twA-1' short-term issuer credit ratings on CTCI Corp. The outlook on the long-term rating is stable. The ratings on CTCI reflect the company's good position in the domestic engineering and construction market, expanding operating scale, and improving business diversity that will underpin its competitive position over the next one to two years. In addition, the ratings reflect our view that CTCI will prudently manage its debt leverage through measures such as equity funding and cap the ratio of debt to EBITDA below 3x in 2025-2027, despite significant growth in capital expenditure (capex).

CTCI's smaller operating scale compared to large-scale global engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) peers, weaker profit margin in its overseas EPC business, and high volatility of the company's leverage for capex and working capital swings somewhat temper these strengths.
